Matt Berman has been passionate about Americanism & Government since growing up in Northwest Ohio. In high school, he took an Americanism test and was selected as one of two students to go to Washington D.C. to participate in what was known as Presidential Classroom, which was a gathering of juniors across the United States. This passion led him to aspire to teach future students about US Government and Politics and he went to Eastern Michigan and received his Bachelors Degree in Education in 2004. He has been teaching US Government, Social Studies, Current Events, and Economics at Washington Local School in Toledo Ohio since for over 21 years.

WHAT MAKES THIS EDUCATOR AN EXCEPTIONAL

INSTRUCTOR? Matt has done an extraordinary job enriching students with his passion for Americanism and US Government studies, and has been the primary contact (as the Chairman of the Social Studies Department) for Conn-Weissenberger Post 587 by arranging the annual Americanism test at Whitmer High School where routinely over 200 students participate in taking the exam each year. The past two years, a student from Whitmer has scored extraordinarily well on the exam (and earning trips to Washington DC) with a junior student from last year scoring a 49/50. Matt also coordinates annually a salute to Veterans each year by organizing a Veterans Assembly at Whitmer High School that includes a free breakfast for veterans in attendance. The assembly is attended by a few hundred students, teachers/school administration, the Whitmer High School band playing a medley of each of the Armed Forces songs and the choir singing patriotic songs. Matt also arranges for the families of recent Whitmer graduates to be in attendance and presented "Blue Star" flags from members of our post. A shining example of Matt's passion for veterans is that he has been "leading the charge" for many years in collecting donations from students for the Gifts for Yanks, and has students present checks to our post representative for monies collected. To date, Whitmer High School students have contributed over \$60,000 to Gifts for Yanks since the program was started. Matt also hosts local veterans each year at a Whitmer varsity football game that includes a "tailgate" before the game, t-shirts recognizing veterans, and a walk-on the field before the game. He is an advocate of Buckeye Boys/Girls State and routinely presents qualified young boys/girls to be interviewed each year that participate in each of the respective programs. Matt has also spearheaded the efforts for the annual Social Studies Department scholarship, which has ultimately brought in \$25,000, allowing the department to award over \$2,000 in scholarships each year to graduating seniors to continue their educational journey.
