## **Ceremony For Regular Meetings**

(Bold-face type below indicates the Commander speaking)

- 1. Opening one rap of gavel (seat those present and have the Sergeant-at-Arms close doors of meeting hall)
- 2. Three raps of gavel (all those present will stand)
- 3. "The Color Bearer(s) (or Sergeant-at-Arms) will advance the Colors."

  "HAND SALUTE!

  TWO!"
- 4. "All in attendance will stand and remain uncovered with their cap removed and placed over the heart from the opening prayer, through the POW/MIA ceremony and concluding with the Pledge of Allegiance."

(Female Legionnaires are afforded the opportunity to leave their cap on during the Pledge of Allegiance, POW/MIA ceremony, while standing in silent reverence in memory of departed comrades, and prayer. See 2020 Officers Guide, p. 40, #8)

5. "The Chaplain will offer prayer."

POW/MIA Empty Chair Ceremony

- 6. "A POW/MIA Empty Chair is placed at all official meetings of The American Legion, as a physical symbol of the thousands of American POW/MIAs still unaccounted for from all wars and conflicts involving the United States of America. This is a reminder for all of us to spare no effort to secure the release of any American prisoners from captivity, the repatriation of the remains of those who died bravely in defense of liberty and a full accounting of those missing. Let us rededicate ourselves for this vital endeavor"
- 7. "We will now recite the Pledge of Allegiance. I pledge allegiance, to the Flag, of the United States of America, and to the Republic for which it stands, one Nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all."

- 8. "Recite in unison the preamble to our Constitution."
