Commander Rue is currently looking to purchase his Commander's vehicle. He will receive 25,000.00 for the car when it is ready.

Wadge increase discussed for Department Staff. Adjutant Robinson will be doing an evaluation of staff to present to the Finance Committee to determine the percentage per employee earned with consideration of what is budget allows.

Adjutant Robinson spoke on the repairs needed to the Department HQ property, which includes painting the building and payment of the parking lot.

There are three different quotes given for painting: \$23,000 (this will include power washing the building and a 5yr guarantee) \$12,000 (Legionnaire Carl Swisher and Son) \$10,000 (will use low-cost paint)

We are still waiting for bids on the parking lot.

Repairs were outside the budget. The Committee will review the budget and see if funds can be pulled from or from extra incoming monies.

Good of the Legion

Rebecca Corbin gave an update on the National Convention and the District Activities Fund. Chairman Lewis asked to research past practices on how and what the money is for.

Department Charities has donated \$40,000 to Department Headquarters.
