RED, WHITE, and BLUE AWARD

The "RED, WHITE, and BLUE" Award is a program of The Ohio American Legion designed to recognize, from a District level, individuals, organizations, businesses, or industries who are promoting Americanism ideals through positive action at a Post level.

This is the American Legion's way of saying "Thank You" to citizens proud to be an American.

Any Post may submit nominations for this award at any time throughout the year. Nominations should be in written form, with as much background information as possible.

Here are some examples:

1. An individual who has faithfully flown the U.S. Flag at their home over a long period of time.
2. An individual or organization responsible for the placing of the U.S Flag at businesses, community sites, and at special sites on all patriotic holidays.
3. Groups of organizations promoting and conducting special patriotic events.
4. Industries that make a special effort to display and fly the Flag at conspicuous places throughout their facilities and promote Americanism to their employees.

All nominations by a post must be submitted to the District Americanism Chairman.

A special "Red, White, and Blue" citation will be prepared by the District Americanism Chairman.

Each District Americanism Chairman may award any number of citations.

It is recommended that if an award is made in your area, members of the local Post, Auxiliary Unit, SAL Squadron, be present and assist in the coverage by the local news media.
