All entries must be submitted in a clear front binder with this entry form as the first two pages. Entries will contain no more than ten (10) additional pages of supporting evidence (photos, newspaper clippings, etc.), using only one side of each page. All entries must be typed.

Be sure this cover page is attached to your report and is signed by your Squadron Advisor or American Legion Post Commander and Squadron Commander.

This form must be sent to Department Headquarters or turned in before the opening session of the Convention in order to qualify for judging.
